Littlemeat Productions, the studio of artist Jennifer Wen Ma, is pleased to announce the launch of *Little Meat Up*, a series of salon-style presentations. The meetings will serve as a venue for artists to share their unique creative processes in an environment that is at once critical and supportive.

Little Meat Ups will be held in bi-annual series of three – three in the fall and three in the spring. The sessions will be informal in nature, and participants will include artists, art professionals, and patrons, among others. Each event will center on a conceptual theme that serves as a point of entry for discussions about art making, with a focus on process and development of new ideas.

In each meeting, two to three artists – of different disciplines and in different stages of their careers – will present either a work in progress or an element of their creative process that they seek feedback from a group workshop. The attendants of the meet up are invited to provide critiques, responses and questions to engaged in a dialogue based on the artists' presentations.

The aim of these sessions is not only to help artists develop their practice, but also to nurture a community of people in the exchange of ideas and open discussion about the creative process. *Little Meat Ups* will also provide an opportunity for interested audiences to have access to new and thought-provoking works, and directly hear the voices of their talented creators.

The first series of three will launch in 2018, and will be held at Jennifer Wen Ma's studio on the Lower East Side of Manhattan. The line up of participating artists will be announced in the summer. The audience attendees will be both invited guests and the public as permitted by space.
